SECTION 2 - CATEGORY OF MEMBERSHIP

The criteria for Full, Ordinary, Associate, Observer membership of EDF are defined in EDF By Laws as follows:

A. FULL MEMBERS

Organisations which fall under any of the following two categories will be considered as full member.

- One National Council of Disabled People from each EU and EEA Member State which:
- 1. has an independent legal status in its own country;
- 2. includes within its membership the most representative organisations of all major impairment groupings, as well as of organisations of parents of disabled people unable to represent themselves, and is open for inclusion of other groups of disabled people;
- 3. has a 51% majority within its membership and within its governing bodies of organisations of disabled people and of parents of disabled people unable to represent themselves.
 - 2) European Non-Governmental Organisations OF disabled people which:
- 1. have a legal status;
- 2. are represented in at least half plus one of the EU/EEA countries and are open to organisations from any EU/EEA country;
- **3.** has a 51% majority within its membership and within its governing bodies of organisations of disabled people and of parents of disabled people unable to represent themselves.
- 4. principal remit of which should relate explicitly to co-operation at European level regarding disability and be consistent with the aims and objectives of the Association as referred to in Article 3 of the EDF Statutes

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B. ORDINARY MEMBERS

European Non-Governmental Organisations FOR disabled people which:

- 1. have a legal status;
- 2. are represented in at least half plus one of the EU/EEA countries and open to organisations from any European country.
- principal remit of which should relate explicitly to cooperation at European level regarding disability and be consistent with the aims and objectives of the Association as referred to in Article 3 of the EDF Statutes.

C. OBSERVER MEMBERS

Observer Members are one National Council of Disabled People from each European country outside the EU/EEA which:

- 1. has an independent legal status in its own country
- 2. includes within its membership representatives of all major impairment groupings, as well as of organisations of parents of disabled people unable to represent themselves, and is open for inclusion of other groups of disabled people;
- 3. has a 51% majority within its membership and within its governing bodies of organisations of disabled people and of parents of disabled people unable to represent themselves.

D. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

Associate members might be non-profit and corporate.

1) Non-profit associate members

Organisations, which are committed to promote the aims and objectives of EDF and which are non-profit. The organisations might be international, national, regional and local, and they must be based or have member associations established in Europe.

2) Corporate associate members

Private companies, which are committed to promote the aims and objectives of EDF.

AIMS and OBJECTIVES of EDF as defined in EDF Statutes

Article 3 – Purpose

The Association's mission is to ensure disabled people full access to



fundamental and human rights through their active involvement in policy development and implementation in Europe.

The objective is to achieve equalisation of opportunities for all women and men with disabilities through influencing the work of all the European institutions, in co-operation with the Social and Civil Partners, institutions and agencies of the EU and EEA, as well as with other European and international organisations and agencies, in accordance with the principle of non-discrimination, and in compliance with EDF's mission statement expressed in the first paragraph of the current article.

This will be achieved through promoting and systematic monitoring of legislative proposals and strategic campaign work to influence policy and practice throughout Europe.

The activities which the Association will undertake to obtain these objectives include:

- Contacts with the relevant institutions and consultative bodies of the EU
- Preparing and disseminating of position papers, periodic information bulletins and other written contributions
- Organisation of conferences and seminars and/or participation in these
- Cooperation and dialogue with other stakeholders, as NGOs, media, trade unions and employers.

All these activities will be undertaken by the Association on the basis of thorough consultation with its members.

The Association shall also defend the interests of its member organisations and of their members' organisations when called upon by them to do so at European level and through its member organisations at national level.

AOPD is a representative Platform of 55 member organizations of civil society, which includes organizations of people with disabilities, parents' associations, organizations providing services for people with disabilities. The mission of AOPD is to improve the quality of life of persons with disabilities in Moldova by monitoring the observance of rights in accordance with the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, which was ratified in 2010.

One of the strategic directions is to increase the capacities of member organizations, namely organizations of people with disabilities, to initiate and engage in advocacy actions and partnerships to ensure an inclusive community.

Analyzing EDF's activity and Strategies, we would like to benefit from the experience and support from the European level in improving the processes that contribute to ensuring the rights of people with disabilities, support in the development of the activist network of people with disabilities at the local and national level.

The rights of people with disabilities and social inclusion mean a wide spectrum of action areas, specific and general, sectoral and intersectoral, which require resources and a systemic approach. Thus, it is important that there are more disabled people, parents' organizations, competent professionals to get involved in solving concrete cases, which will have an impact on a significant number of people.

In this sense EDF's experience is valuable for AOPD.

Association Alliance of Organizations for Persons with Disabilities is a national network of 55 civil society organizations that unify their effort to advocates for the rights of persons with disabilities.

Mission AOPD

Improving the quality of life of people with disabilities in Moldova by working with state authorities to create an environment with equal opportunities for people with disabilities to achieve their potential.

AOPD objectives:

- 1. Capacity building of AOPD as a structure of NGOs in the disability field to be united and work functionally with state institutions to improve the quality of life of people with disabilities in Moldova:
- 2. Promoting the rights of people with disabilities through advocacy and developing functional partnerships with public authorities of the Republic of Moldova;
- 3. Informing and raising awareness of public opinion on people with disabilities, existing problems, their potential and the need for social integration.

Background

Only when 2000 started, Moldovan civil society increasingly came to realize that to make lasting changes that matter and to improve the quality of life of people with disabilities and other vulnerable people in our country, and to have functional work with government structures, to solve problems a unified effort is necessary. In response to this need, in 2001, following a national forum of NGOs (the first of its kind in the country) was formed Alliance of Active NGOs in Social Protection of Persons with Disabilities. It was formed as part of Social Network a large network of NGOs. Social Network was comprised of six smaller networks and one of them was the Alliance of Active NGOs working in the Field of Social Protection of People with Disabilities. At first, the Alliance was more a non-formal network, but its members, active NGOs from the field of disability, had a memorandum of cooperation and joint activities and projects. In 2007, the Alliance was registered as a legal entity at the Ministry of Justice RM with the official name Alliance of Organizations for People with Disabilities from Moldova (AOPD). The members of the Alliance are active NGOs from the field of disability.

The area of expertise of AOPD are:

- Educational inclusion
- Employment of people with disabilities
- Deinstitutionalization and development of the community based services
- Early intervention
- Accessibility

The working strategies of AOPD are:

- Monitoring the legal framework and social policies in order to improve the degree of implementation of the rights of persons with disabilities;
- Organizing national and international advocacy actions to improve the implementation of the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities;
- Participation in working groups for the elaboration of the legal framework and social policies in order to include the dimension of the rights of persons with disabilities;
- Empowering and strengthening member organizations to act as a force in defense of the rights of persons with disabilities;
- Organization of information campaigns for the general public to change the attitude towards people with disabilities in the one based on dignity and human rights.
- Elaboration of reports and studies in the field of respecting the rights of persons with disabilities.
